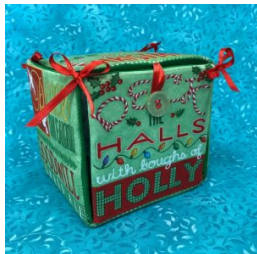
Choose two coordinating fabrics for 2 gift bags. A versatile pattern, you can use the same techniques for making different size bags.

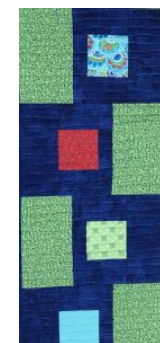
How many hot pads can you make from one metre of fabric, some batting and binding? I made 10! Makes a great hostess gift.
